LONG LIVE LIBERTY



“Every five years from the ratification of this constitution, there shall be an election on the first Tuesday in February. The population shall vote for the party they think would best run the government. The seats awarded to each party shall be proportional to the population that voted for that party.

The party’s leadership shall fill the position with the candidates they think are best. On the first Tuesday in November of the same year, an election will be held to determine how much weight the vote of a member will count. The weight will be equal to the number of people who voted for them.

A person shall be able to cast one vote per council per election.”

– Article IV (Elections),
